Introduction

What is a prophecy?

Many people have many ideas about what a prophecy is. Merriam-Webster gives this definition:

1. an inspired utterance of a prophet
2. the function or vocation of a prophet
specifically: the inspired declaration of divine will and purpose
3. a divinely inspired utterance or revelation: oracular prophecies
4. a prediction of something to come

This document covers prophecies that fall under the third definition, "a prediction of something to come." Of course most these prophecies have already occurred but when they were written they were "predictions of something to come."

The word prediction, however, is a false word to use for biblical prophecies. With biblical prophecies, the word "prediction" can be eliminated. As you'll be able to see with the sections of this document that cover prophecies that have occurred, biblical prophecies aren't predictions; they are descriptions of events, most have taken place; others haven't -- yet. .

It is commonly estimated that over 1/3 of the bible is prophecy. Most sources state that over 300 of them have been fulfilled. .

All the Bible quotes in this document are from the New King James Version of the Bible.

Jesus' Ministry

Prophecies about Jesus' ministry will be covered here. After each Old Testament prophecy is the New Testament fulfillment of the prophecy.

This first prophecy, although nearly fulfilled by Jesus' crucifixion, is an end time prophecy that is yet to be fulfilled also.

Christ's ministry will destroy the devil's work

Prophecy written between 1450 and 1410 BC

Genesis 3:15

¹⁵ And I will put enmity
Between you and the woman,
And between your seed and her Seed;
He shall bruise your head,
And you shall bruise His heel."

Partially fulfilled 30 AD.

1 John 3:8

My ears You have opened.

Burnt offering and sin offering You did not require.

⁷Then I said, “Behold, I come;
In the scroll of the book *it is* written of me.

⁸I delight to do Your will, O my God,
And Your law *is* within my heart.”

Hebrews 10:5-10

⁵Therefore, when He came into the world, He said:

“Sacrifice and offering You did not desire,
But a body You have prepared for Me.

⁶In burnt offerings and *sacrifices* for sin

In the volume of the book it is written of Me—
To do Your will, O God.’ ”

⁸Previously saying, “Sacrifice and offering, burnt offerings,

And their ears heavy,
And shut their eyes;
Lest they see with their eyes,
And hear with their ears,
And understand with their heart,
And return and be healed."

Isaiah 8:14

As a trap and a snare to the inhabitants of Jerusalem.

Fulfilled 26 to 30 AD

1 Peter 2:7-8

⁷ Therefore, to you who believe, *He* is precious; but to those who are disobedient,
“The stone which the builders rejected
Has become the chief cornerstone,”
⁸ and “A stone of stumbling
And a rock of offense.”
They stumble, being disobedient to the word, to which they also were appointed.

Jesus' ministry begins in Galilee

Prophecy written between 701 to 681 BC

Isaiah 9:1-2

⁹ Nevertheless the gloom *will not be* upon her who *is* distressed,
As when at first He lightly esteemed
The land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali,
And afterward more heavily oppressed *her*,
By the way of the sea, beyond the Jordan,
In Galilee of the Gentiles.

² The people who walked in darkness
Have seen a great light;
Those who dwelt in the land of the shadow of death,
Upon them a light has shined.

Fulfilled 26 to 30 AD

Matthew 4:12-17

¹² Now when Jesus heard that John had been put in prison, He departed to Galilee. ¹³ And leaving Nazareth, He came and dwelt in Capernaum, which is by the sea, in the regions of Zebulun and Naphtali, ¹⁴ that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying:

Christ's predecessor will come in the spirit of Elijah

Prophecy written between 568-433 BC.

Malachi 4:5-6

⁵ Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet
Before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the LORD.

⁶ And he will turn

The hearts of the fathers to the children,
And the hearts of the children to their fathers,
Lest I come and strike the earth with a curse."

Fulfilled around 7 BC

Matthew 11:10-15

¹⁰ For this is *he* of whom it is written:

'Behold, I send My messenger before Your face,
Who will prepare Your way before You.'

¹¹ "Assuredly, I say to you, among those born of women there has not risen one greater than John the Baptist; but he who is least in the kingdom of heaven is greater than he. ¹² And from the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffers violence, and the violent take it by force. ¹³ For all the prophets and the law prophesied until John. ¹⁴ And if you are willing to receive *it*, he is Elijah who is to come. ¹⁵ He who has ears to hear, let him hear!

Jesus redeems the Gentiles

Prophecy written between 701 to 681 BC

Isaiah 42:1-4

"Behold! My Servant whom I uphold,
My Elect One *in whom* My soul delights!
I have put My Spirit upon Him;
He will bring forth justice to the Gentiles.

² He will not cry out, nor raise *His voice*,
Nor cause His voice to be heard in the street.

³ A bruised reed He will not break,
And smoking flax He will not quench;
He will bring forth justice for truth.

⁴ He will not fail nor be discouraged,
Till He has established justice in the earth;
And the coastlands shall wait for His law."

Fulfilled 26 to 30 AD

Matthew 12:15-21

¹⁵ But when Jesus knew *it*, He withdrew from there. And great multitudes followed Him, and He healed them all. Yet He warned them not to make Him known, ¹⁷ that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying:

¹⁸ "Behold! My Servant whom I have chosen,
My Beloved in whom My soul is well pleased!
I will put My Spirit upon Him,
And He will declare justice to the Gentiles.

And we hid, as it were, *our* faces from Him;
He was despised, and we did not esteem Him.

Luke 4:28-29

²⁸ So all those in the synagogue, when they heard these things, were filled with wrath, ²⁹ and rose up and thrust Him out of the city; and they led Him to the brow of the hill on which their city was built, that they might throw Him down over the cliff.

Prophecy written between 701 to 681 BC

Isaiah 61:1

61 "The Spirit of the Lord GOD *is* upon Me,
Because the LORD has anointed Me
To preach good tidings to the poor;
He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted,
To proclaim liberty to the captives,
And the opening of the prison to *those who are* bound;

Fulfilled 26 to 30 AD

Luke 4:16-21

¹⁶ So He came to Nazareth, where He had been brought up. And as His custom was, He went into the synagogue on the Sabbath day, and stood up to read. ¹⁷ And He was handed the book of the prophet Isaiah. And when He had opened the book, He found the place where it was written:

¹⁸ "The Spirit of the LORD *is* upon Me,
Because He has anointed Me

¹⁴ Then to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom,
That all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him.
His dominion *is* an everlasting dominion,

Prophecy written between 520 to 488 BC

Zechariah 9:9

⁹“Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion!
Shout, O daughter of Jerusalem!
Behold, your King is coming to you;
He *is* just and having salvation,
Lowly and riding on a donkey,
A colt, the foal of a donkey.

Fulfilled 30 AD

Matthew 21:8-10

⁸ And a very great multitude spread their clothes on the road; others cut down branches from the trees and spread *them* on the road. ⁹ Then the multitudes who went before and those who followed cried out, saying: “Hosanna to the Son of David!

⁵⁴ So when this corruptible has put on incorruption, and this mortal has put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written: “Death is swallowed up in victory.”

The Messiah makes a new covenant

Prophecy written between 647-580 BC.

Jeremiah 31:31

³¹ “Behold, the days are coming, says the LORD, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah—

Fulfilled 30 AD.

Matthew 26:28

²⁸ For this is My blood of the new covenant, which is shed for many for the remission of sins.

Luke 22:20

²⁰ Likewise He also *took* the cup after supper, saying, “This cup *is* the new covenant in My blood, which is shed for you.

1 Corinthians 11:25

²⁵ In the same manner *He* also *took* the cup after supper, saying, “This cup is the new covenant in My blood. This do, as often as you drink *it*, in remembrance of Me.”

2 Corinthians 3:6

⁷ For if that first *covenant* had been faultless, then no place would have been sought for a second. ⁸ Because finding fault with them, He says: “Behold, the days are coming, says the LORD, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah— ⁹ not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day when I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt; because they did not continue in My covenant, and I disregarded them, says the LORD. ¹⁰ For this *is* the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the LORD: I will put My laws in their mind and write them on their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people. ¹¹ None of them shall teach his neighbor, and none his brother, saying, ‘Know the LORD,’ for all shall know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them. ¹² For I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their lawless deeds I will remember no more.”

¹³ In that He says, “A new *covenant*,” He has made the first obsolete. Now what is becoming obsolete and growing old is ready to vanish away.

Prophecy written between 1440 BC and 586 BC.

Psalm 68:18

¹⁸ You have ascended on high,
You have led captivity captive;
You have received gifts among men,
Even *from* the rebellious,
That the LORD God might dwell *there*.

Fulfilled 30 AD.

Ephesians 4:7-16

⁷ But to each one of us grace was given according to the measure of Christ's gift. ⁸ Therefore He says:

"When He ascended on high,
He led captivity captive,
And gave gifts to men."

⁹ (Now this, "He ascended"—what does it mean but that He also first descended into the lower parts of the earth? ¹⁰ He who descended is also the One who ascended far above all the heavens, that He might fill all things.)

¹¹ And He Himself gave some *to be* apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, ¹² for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ, ¹³ till we all come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ; ¹⁴ that we should no longer be children, tossed to and fro and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the trickery of men, in the cunning craftiness of deceitful plotting, ¹⁵ but, speaking the truth in love, may grow up in all things into Him who is the head—Christ—¹⁶ from whom the whole body, joined and knit together by what every joint supplies, according to the effective working by which every part does its share, causes growth of the body for the edifying of itself in love.

Jesus' Death

These prophecies of Jesus' death were all fulfilled upon his death in 30 AD.

Jesus will be betrayed by a friend

Babylon rules over Judah for 70 years

Prophecy written between 626 to 586 BC

Jeremiah 25:11-12

¹¹ And this whole land shall be a desolation *and* an astonishment, and these nations shall serve the king of Babylon seventy years.

¹² 'Then it will come to pass, when seventy years are completed, *that* I will punish the king of Babylon and that nation, the land of the Chaldeans, for their iniquity,' says the LORD; 'and I will make it a perpetual desolation.'

Fulfilled 539 BC

Babylon captured the last Assyrian king and took over their possessions, including Israel in 609 BC. Babylon took many Jews captive and destroyed Jerusalem and the temple. Cyrus, a leader of the Persians and Medes, conquered Babylon in 539 BC. This ended domination of the Jews and the Babylonian empire.

Fulfilled again in 516 BC

The Babylonians destroyed the Jerusalem Temple in 586 BC. 70 years later, in 516 BC, the Jews rebuilt and consecrated it. This ended Babylonian domination.

Babylon's gates open for Cyrus

Prophecy written between 701 and 681 BC.

Isaiah 45:1

45 "Thus says the LORD to His anointed,
To Cyrus, whose right hand I have held—
To subdue nations before him
And loose the armor of kings,
To open before him the double doors,
So that the gates will not be shut:

Fulfilled 539 BC

The Persian king Cyrus conquered Babylon in 539 BC. Despite the walls that surrounded Babylon being over 70-foot thick and 300-feet high and having 250 watch towers, Cyrus entered the huge city and conquered it. Cyrus accomplished this by diverting the flow of the Euphrates River into a large lake basin, which enabled Cyrus and his army to march across the riverbed and into the city.

Babylon's kingdom is permanently overthrown

Prophecy written between 701 and 681 BC.

Isaiah 13:19

¹⁹ And Babylon, the glory of kingdoms,
The beauty of the Chaldeans' pride,
Will be as when God overthrew Sodom and Gomorrah.

Fulfilled in 539 BC

History verifies that following Cyrus' destroyed the Babylon kingdom in 539 BC. It never rose to power again.

Babylon reduced to ruins

Prophecy written between 701 and 681 BC.

Jeremiah 51:11

¹¹ Make the arrows bright!
Gather the shields!
The Lord has raised up the spirit of the kings of the Medes.
For His plan is against Babylon to destroy it,
Because it is the vengeance of the LORD,
The vengeance for His temple.

Her whole land shall be ashamed,
And all her slain shall fall in her midst.

⁴⁹ As Babylon has caused the slain of Israel to fall,

Fulfilled after 539 BC

Years after Cyrus conquered Babylon the buildings of the city became irrecoverable

ruins. However, the sinfulness, the impious culture and antichrist ideology of the Babylon Empire continues to this day. It has appeared again in the apostate church, and according to Revelation 17 and its political power will be established in the final form of the Roman Empire, as Revelation 18 describes.

God rescues the Jews from Babylonian rule and brings them to safety

Prophecy written between 626 to 586 BC

Jeremiah 32:36-37

³⁶ “Now therefore, thus says the LORD, the God of Israel, concerning this city of which you say, ‘It shall be delivered into the hand of the king of Babylon by the sword, by the famine, and by the pestilence: ³⁷ Behold, I will gather them out of all countries where I have driven them in My anger, in My fury, and in great wrath; I will bring them back to this place, and I will cause them to dwell safely.

Fulfilled in 538 BC

Many Jews were taken as captives to Babylon around 605 BC. In 538 BC, they were freed and many returned to Israel.

In their final hours the Ninevites will be drunk

Prophecies written about 614 BC

Nahum 1:10

¹⁰ For while tangled *like* thorns,
And while drunken *like* drunkards,
They shall be devoured like stubble fully dried.

Nahum 3:11

¹¹ You also will be drunk;
You will be hidden;
You also will seek refuge from the enemy.

Fulfilled between 613 and 611 BC.

An ancient historian, Diodorus Siculus, wrote: "The Assyrian king gave much wine to his soldiers. Deserters told this to the enemy, who attacked that night."

Ninevah destroyed by fire

Prophecy written around 614 BC

Nahum 3:15

¹⁵ There the fire will devour you,
The sword will cut you off;
It will eat you up like a locust.
Make yourself many—like the locust!
Make yourself many—like the *swarming* locusts!

Fulfilled around 612 BC

In the 1800s archaeologists dug up the site and found a layer of ash blanketing the ruins.

Tyre attacked by many nations

Prophecy written between 587 and 586 BC

Ezekiel 26:3

³“Therefore thus says the Lord GOD: ‘Behold, I *am* against you, O Tyre, and will cause many nations to come up against you, as the sea causes its waves to come up.

Fulfilled in 573 BC, 332 BC and 1291 AD

Tyre, the Phoenician Empire’s most powerful city, consistently mistreated Israel. Consequently many nations attacked Tyre. Around the same time that Ezekiel made this prophecy Babylon began an attack on Tyre that lasted 13 years. About 332 BC Alexander the Great defeated Tyre, which ended the Phoenician Empire. Later, Tyre was ruled by the Romans, then the Crusaders, then the Moslems, who destroyed the city in 1291.

Tyre’s stones, timber and soil thrown into the sea

Prophecy written between 587-586 BC

Ezekiel 26:12

¹² They will plunder your riches and pillage your merchandise; they will break down your walls and destroy your pleasant houses; they will lay your stones, your timber, and your soil in the midst of the water.

Fulfilled in 333 to 332 BC

Alexander the Great built a land bridge from the mainland to the island, Tyre. Historians believe that Alexander took the rubble from Tyre’s ruins--stones, timber and soil--and tossed it into the sea to build the land bridge (which is still there)..

Edom will be destroyed

Prophecy written between 626 to 586 BC

Jeremiah 49:18-20

¹⁸ As in the overthrow of Sodom and Gomorrah

And their neighbors,” says the LORD,

“No one shall remain there,

Nor shall a son of man dwell in it.

¹⁹ “Behold, he shall come up like a lion from the floodplain of the Jordan

Against the dwelling place of the strong;

But I will suddenly make him run away from her.

And who *is* a chosen *man that* I may appoint over her?

For who *is* like Me?

Who will arraign Me?

And who *is* that shepherd

Who will withstand Me?”

²⁰ Therefore hear the counsel of the LORD that He has taken against Edom, And His purposes that He has proposed against the inhabitants of Teman:

Surely the least of the flock shall draw them out;
Surely He shall make their dwelling places desolate with them.

Fulfilled approximately 100 BC

Petra, the capital city of Edom, even though it was carved out of a mountain side was destroyed. Edom doesn't exist anymore, but Petra became a part of Jordan. In 106 AD, Petra was conquered by the Romans but was rebuilt shortly after. Petra was conquered by the Muslims in the 7th Century and by the Crusaders in the 12th Century and eventually reduced to ruin.

Israel will be scattered

Prophecy written between 1440 and 1400 BC

Leviticus 26:33

³³ I will scatter you among the nations and draw out a sword after you;
your land shall be desolate and your cities waste.

These two prophecies were written around 622 BC

Deuteronomy 4:27

And the LORD will scatter you among the peoples, and you will be left few in number among the nations where the LORD will drive you.

Deuteronomy 28:64

⁶⁴ "Then the LORD will scatter you among all peoples, from one end of the earth to the other, and there you shall serve other gods, which neither you nor your fathers have known—wood and stone.

Prophecy written between 630 and 680 BC

Jeremiah 9:16

¹⁶ I will scatter them also among the Gentiles, whom neither they nor their fathers have known. And I will send a sword after them until I have consumed them."

Prophecy written between 1440-586 BC.

Psalms 106:24-27

²⁴ Then they despised the pleasant land;

They did not believe His word,

²⁵ But complained in their tents,

And did not heed the voice of the LORD.

²⁶ Therefore He raised His hand *in an oath* against them,

To overthrow them in the wilderness,

²⁷ To overthrow their descendants among the nations,

And to scatter them in the lands.

These three prophecies from Ezekiel were written between 593 and 565 BC

Prophecy written between 630 and 580 BC

Prophecy written between 445 and 420 BC

Nehemiah 1:8

⁸ Remember, I pray, the word that You commanded Your servant Moses, saying, ‘If you [are](#) unfaithful, I will scatter you among the nations;

Continues to be fulfilled

Hitler exterminated 6 million Jews, thousands were slaughtered during the Crusades (1000-1300 AD), all Jews were ordered out of Spain in 1492 and out of Portugal in 1497. These are only a few of the documented cases of the onslaught and persecution of Jews. Any encyclopedia will list many more.

Israel will be victorious over its enemies

Prophecy written between 701 to 681 BC

Isaiah 41:12-14

¹² You shall seek them and not find them—

Those who contended with you.

Those who war against you

Shall be as nothing,

As a nonexistent thing.

¹³ For I, the LORD your God, will hold your right hand,

Saying to you, ‘Fear not, I will help you.’

¹⁴ “Fear not, you worm Jacob,

You men of Israel!

I will help you,” says the LORD

And your Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel.

Fulfilled in 1948

In 1948 Israel established its homeland again and since has been attacked often, yet has always prevailed in these attacks.

Israel will be rebuilt

Prophecy written about 750 BC

Amos 9:11-13

¹¹ “On that day I will raise up
The tabernacle of David, which has fallen down,
And repair its damages;
I will raise up its ruins,
And rebuild it as in the days of old;
¹³ “Behold, the days are coming,” says the LORD,
“When the plowman shall overtake the reaper,
And the treader of grapes him who sows seed;
The mountains shall drip with sweet wine,
And all the hills shall flow *with it*.”

After being destroyed by the Assyrians and Romans and having been in ruins for the past 2000 years, the Jews who were scattered all over the world started returning to Israel during the past 100 years. After using highly advanced irrigation and farming procedures, the returning Jews have turned much of Israel into productive farmland and has turned it into the source of food for many countries.

Prosperity promised to Israel

Prophecy written between 593-571 BC

Ezekiel 36:11

¹¹ I will multiply upon you man and beast; and they shall increase and bear young; I will make you inhabited as in former times, and do better *for you* than at your beginnings. Then you shall know that I *am* the LORD.

Fulfilled during the past 100 years

After enjoying prosperity 3,000 years ago, Israel fell into ruins and devastation for thousands of years. Israel's prosperity has been re-established during the past 100 years.

Trees again grow in Israel

Prophecy written between 701-681 BC

Isaiah 41:18-20

¹⁸ I will open rivers in desolate heights,
And fountains in the midst of the valleys;
I will make the wilderness a pool of water,
And the dry land springs of water.
¹⁹ I will plant in the wilderness the cedar and the acacia tree,

The myrtle and the oil tree;
I will set in the desert the cypress tree *and* the pine
And the box tree together,
²⁰ That they may see and know,
And consider and understand together,
That the hand of the LORD has done this,
And the Holy One of Israel has created it.

Fulfilled during the 1900's

Israel had become desolate and remained so for much of the past 2000 years, mostly because of the lack of available water. During the 1900s, after many Jews returned home, they built irrigation systems and planted 200 million trees, which flourished.

Israel's fruit fills the world

Prophecy written between 701-681 BC

Isaiah 27:6

⁶ Those who come He shall cause to take root in Jacob;
Israel shall blossom and bud,
And fill the face of the world with fruit.

Fulfilled in the late 1900's

After being barren for centuries, Israel has become a leading producer of agriculture products and also exports food to other countries. Also, Christianity had began in Israel and now has around 2 billion followers now.

Egypt will not rule over other nations

Prophecy written between 593-571 BC

Ezekiel 29:15

¹⁵ It shall be the lowliest of kingdoms; it shall never again exalt itself above the nations, for I will diminish them so that they will not rule over the nations anymore.

Continues to be fulfilled

Before Ezekiel, Egypt had dominated many nations, including Israel, for centuries. During the last 2500 years, however, Egypt has been controlled by the Romans, the Ottomans and the Europeans. Egypt has unsuccessfully tried to dominate Israel at least 3 times in the 20th century. Egypt hasn't ruled over any other nation since Ezekiel's time.

The Jews return to Jerusalem

Prophecy written between 520 and 518 BC

Zechariah 8:7-8

'Behold, I will save My people from the land of the east
And from the land of the west;

⁸ I will bring them *back*,
And they shall dwell in the midst of Jerusalem.
They shall be My people
And I will be their God,
In truth and righteousness.'

Fulfilled in 1967

Jerusalem and took many Jews captive about 2600 years ago. Many Jews returned later and rebuilt Jerusalem. The city, however, was destroyed about 1900 years ago by the Romans. The Romans killed more than a million and forced many into exile. In 1967, however, the Jews again took back control of Jerusalem during the Six Day War.

Israel's deserts become like the Garden of Eden

Prophecy written between 701-681 BC

Isaiah 51:3

³ For the LORD will comfort Zion,
He will comfort all her waste places;
He will make her wilderness like Eden,
And her desert like the garden of the LORD;
Joy and gladness will be found in it,
Thanksgiving and the voice of melody.

Fulfilled during the 1900's

During the 1900s the Jews have reconditioned a desolate country through advanced cultivation and irrigation techniques. In the late 1800s Israel was almost a wasteland but has become a major food source for many countries. In the last century over 200 million trees have been planted and are thriving in Israel.

Massive number of Jews would return to Israel

Prophecy written between 701-681 BC

Isaiah 43:5-6

⁵ Fear not, for I *am* with you;
I will bring your descendants from the east,
And gather you from the west;
⁶ I will say to the north, 'Give them up!'
And to the south, 'Do not keep them back!'
Bring My sons from afar,
And My daughters from the ends of the earth—

Fulfilled early 1900's

Jews living in the Middle East moved to Israel, as well as hundreds of thousands living in Europe and the United States. At first Russia forbid Jews to move to

Israel, but they relented to pressure put on them from other countries and permitted Jews to move to Israel during the 1980s. Hundreds of thousands moved to Israel from Russia since then. Ethiopia, south of Israel, didn't allow Jews to move to Israel. However, in 1985 Israel and Ethiopia's communist government came to terms and Ethiopia allowed Jews to move to Israel. Ethiopia was paid a ransom, but on May 25, 1991, 14,500 Jews were airlifted back to Israel.

End time prophecies

There will be proud, self-loving, disobedient blasphemers

2 Timothy 3:1-2

¹ But know this, that in the last days perilous times will come: ² For men will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy,

Prophecies to be fulfilled

The Rapture

Because it's a future event and because the Bible can be interpreted in different ways by different people, when the rapture will occur is controversial. I found four beliefs:

- 1. Pre-tribulation: Many Christian and biblical scholars believe it will occur before the tribulation begins.*
- 2. Partial rapture: Some believe that only Christians who are faithful will be raptured before the tribulation, but that unfaithful Christians will remain on earth to live through it.*
- 3. Mid-tribulation: Some believe that Christians will be raptured half-way through the tribulation.*
- 4. Post-tribulation: Others believe that Christians are raptured when the tribulation period ends, when Christ returns to judge us.*

Daniel 12:1-2

12 "At that time Michael shall stand up,
The great prince who stands *watch* over the sons of your people;
And there shall be a time of trouble,
Such as never was since there was a nation,
Even to that time.
And at that time your people shall be delivered,
Every one who is found written in the book.

Some to shame *and* everlasting contempt.

One world government

The attempt at establishing a one world government began in 2100 BC with King Nimrod. He wanted to build a tower where people could live and survive a flood, primarily to spite God and His powers. Josephus, an ancient historian who was born in Jerusalem between 37 and 18 AD wrote:

“Now it was Nimrod who excited them to such an affront and contempt of God. He was the grandson of Ham the son of Noah. He was a bold man, and of great strength of hand. He persuaded them not to ascribe it to God, as if it was through his means they

were happy, but to believe that it was their own courage, which procured that happiness. He also gradually changed the government into tyranny, seeing no other way of turning men from the fear of God, but to bring them into a constant dependence on his power...(Josephus, Flavius Translated by William Whiston, The Works of Josephus, Hendrickson Publishers Peabody, MA 01916-3473, 1987, Pg. 35 Antiquities of the Jews Chapter 4:2)”

Basically, the Tower of Babel was an attempt for humans to establish and live according to their own laws and rules, apart from God.

God blessed humans and told them in Genesis 1:28 to “Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it;...” The Tower of Babel was in direct disobedience, as it was a human attempt to settle everyone in one location and to establish human rule over divine rule.

1 Chronicles 1:10

¹⁰ Cush begot Nimrod; he began to be a mighty one on the earth.

Psalm 2:2-3

² The kings of the earth set themselves,
And the rulers take counsel together,
Against the Lord and against His Anointed, saying,

The attempt to establish a New World Order (one world government) began to accelerate in the 1900's. Below is a list, in date order, of significant creations of organizations working in conjunction with the attempt to establish a New World Order.

1935: A NWO symbol appears on the back of the US dollar bill

1940: H. G. Wells publishes a book entitled 'The New World Order'

1945: UN is founded

1948: World Council of Churches (WCC) is formed

1954: Bilderberg Group is formed by Joseph Rettinger and Prince Bernard of the Netherlands, and funded by the Rockefellers.

1957: EEC is formed under 'The Treaties of Rome'

1968: Club of Rome is formed

1973: Trilateral Commission is formed

1974: Universal Product Code (UPC) introduced in retail stores

1990: George H.W. Bush spoke on 'Toward a New World Order'

1995: World Trade Organization (WTO) is formed

2002: American FDA approved the 'VeriChip' (human implanted microchip for electronic ID)

2009: The body responsible for managing the Internet, Ican, takes over from the U.S. to become more global

2010: Creation of a European Army receives strong backing from Germany

2012: German Finance Minister says: "the euro region needs 'a real fiscal union'"

A biblical prophecy written between 540 and 530 BC by Daniel describes a great statue that symbolise four great empires that would rule over Israel.

Four empires that will rule over Israel's kingdom: Babylonian empire, 612 BC; Medo Persian Empire, 539 BC, Greek Empire 330 BC, Roman Empire 63 BC, Revived Roman Empire -- future.

Daniel 2:31-35

³¹ "You, O king, were watching; and behold, a great image! This great image, whose splendor was excellent, stood before you; and its form was awesome. ³² This image's head was of fine gold, its chest and arms of silver, its belly and thighs of bronze, ³³ its legs of iron, its feet partly of iron and partly of clay. ³⁴ You watched while a stone was cut out without hands, which struck the image on its feet of iron and clay, and broke them in pieces. ³⁵ Then the iron, the clay, the bronze, the silver, and the gold were crushed together, and became like chaff from the summer threshing floors; the wind carried them away so that no trace of them was found. And the stone that struck the image became a great mountain and filled the whole earth.

New World Order dream interpretation given to Daniel

Daniel 2:36-43

³⁶ "This is the dream. Now we will tell the interpretation of it before the king. ³⁷ You, O king, are a king of kings. For the God of heaven has given you a kingdom, power, strength, and glory; ³⁸ and wherever the children of men dwell, or the beasts of the field and the birds of the heaven, He has given them into your hand, and has made you ruler over them all—you are this head of gold. ³⁹ But after you shall arise another kingdom inferior to yours; then another, a third kingdom of bronze, which shall rule over all the earth. ⁴⁰ And the fourth kingdom shall be as strong as iron, inasmuch as iron breaks in pieces and shatters everything; and like iron that crushes, that kingdom will break in pieces and crush all the others. ⁴¹ Whereas you saw the feet and toes, partly of potter's clay and partly of iron, the kingdom shall be divided; yet the strength of the iron shall be in it, just as you saw the iron mixed with ceramic clay. ⁴² And as the toes of the feet were partly of iron and partly of clay, so the kingdom shall be partly strong and partly fragile. ⁴³ As you saw iron mixed with ceramic clay, they will mingle with the seed of men; but they will not adhere to one another, just as iron does not mix with clay.

Daniel 7:23-25

²³ "Thus he said:

'The fourth beast shall be
A fourth kingdom on earth,
Which shall be different from all *other* kingdoms,
And shall devour the whole earth,
Trample it and break it in pieces.

²⁴ The ten horns *are* ten kings
Who shall arise from this kingdom.
And another shall rise after them;
He shall be different from the first *ones*,
And shall subdue three kings.

²⁵ He shall speak *pompous* words against the Most High,
Shall persecute the saints of the Most High,
And shall intend to change times and law.
Then *the saints* shall be given into his hand
For a time and times and half a time.

These ten kings (world leaders) give their power and strength to the beast kingdom which will then rule the entire earth. If this were to happen today, the ten kings might represent the USA, Russia, China, India, United Kingdom, France, Germany and three other countries.

Daniel 11:36-39

³⁶ “Then the king shall do according to his own will: he shall exalt and magnify himself above every god, shall speak blasphemies against the God of gods, and shall prosper till the wrath has been accomplished; for what has been determined shall be done. ³⁷ He shall regard neither the God of his fathers nor the desire of women, nor regard any god; for he shall exalt himself above them all. ³⁸ But in their place he shall honor a god of fortresses; and a god which his fathers did not know he shall honor with gold and silver, with precious stones and pleasant things. ³⁹ Thus he shall act against the strongest fortresses with a foreign god, which he shall acknowledge, and advance its glory; and he shall cause them to rule over many, and divide the land for gain.

Apparently, regardless of the reckless attempt of humans to establish the New World Order, it is primarily going to be established by the Antichrist who will dominate the world by conquering countries and will convince leaders to surrender their power to him.

The AntiChrist

Daniel 7:8

⁸ I was considering the horns, and there was another horn, a little one, coming up among them, before whom three of the first horns were plucked out by the roots. And there, in this horn, were eyes like the eyes of a man, and a mouth speaking pompous words.

The AntiChrist is mentioned, as the antichrist, only 4 times in scripture, all in John's epistles.

The Beast

Daniel speaks of four beasts below. These beasts represent 4 empires: Babylonian, Medo-Persian (Iran), Greek and Roman.

Daniel 7:3-7

³ And four great beasts came up from the sea, each different from the other.

⁴ The first was like a lion, and had eagle's wings. I watched till its wings were plucked off; and it was lifted up from the earth and made to stand on two feet like a man, and a man's heart was given to it. ⁵ "And suddenly another beast, a second, like a bear. It was raised up on one side, and had three ribs in its mouth between its teeth. And they said thus to it: 'Arise, devour much flesh!' ⁶ "After this I looked, and there was another, like a leopard, which had on its back four wings of a bird. The beast also had four heads, and dominion was given to it.

⁷ "After this I saw in the night visions, and behold, a fourth beast, dreadful and terrible, exceedingly strong. It had huge iron teeth; it was devouring, breaking in pieces, and trampling the residue with its feet. It was different from all the beasts that were before it, and it had ten horns.

The beast mentioned below represents the Roman Empire.

Revelation 13:1-4

13 Then I stood on the sand of the sea. And I saw a beast rising up out of the sea, having seven heads and ten horns, and on his horns ten crowns, and on his heads a blasphemous name. ² Now the beast which I saw was like a leopard, his feet were like the feet of a bear, and his mouth like the mouth of a lion. The dragon gave him his power, his throne, and great authority. ³ And I saw one of his heads as if it had been mortally wounded, and his deadly wound was healed. And all the world marveled and followed the beast. ⁴ So they worshiped the dragon who gave authority to the beast; and they worshiped the beast, saying, "Who is like the beast? Who is able to make war with him?"

This beast mentioned below is likely the political and military dictator of that empire.

Revelation 13:5-8

⁵ And he was given a mouth speaking great things and blasphemies, and he was given authority to continue for forty-two months. ⁶ Then he opened his mouth in blasphemy against God, to blaspheme His name, His tabernacle, and those who dwell in heaven. ⁷ It was granted to him to make war with the saints and to overcome them. And authority was given him over every tribe, tongue, and nation. ⁸ All who dwell on the earth will worship him, whose names have not been written in the Book of Life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world.

The beast spoken of below is perhaps a powerful religious authority claiming to represent Christ; a tool of Satan trying to deceive the masses.

¹¹ Then I saw another beast coming up out of the earth, and he had two horns like a lamb and spoke like a dragon. ¹² And he exercises all the authority of the first beast in his presence, and causes the earth and those who dwell in it to worship the first beast, whose deadly wound was healed. ¹³ He performs great signs, so that he even makes fire come down from heaven on the earth in the sight of men. ¹⁴ And he deceives those who dwell on the earth by those signs which he was granted to do in the sight of the beast, telling those who dwell on the earth to make an image to the beast who was wounded by the sword and lived.

The False Prophet

The False Prophet is probably the spiritual leader of a wealthy and esteemed religion, referred to in Revelation as the Great Whore. This leader denies the sovereign authority of God and that Jesus Christ is the Son of God. The False Prophet is the spiritual leader of all those who submit to the Beast system. The False Prophet is called such because he promotes a system that is directly

opposed to the worship of God the Father and Jesus Christ. The False Prophet has remarkable supernatural power and he uses it to deceive and control people.

Revelation 13:11-18

¹¹ Then I saw another beast coming up out of the earth, and he had two horns like a lamb and spoke like a dragon. ¹² And he exercises all the authority of the first beast in his presence, and causes the earth and those who dwell in it to worship the first beast, whose deadly wound was healed.

The Marriage Supper of the Lamb

Satan bound in the bottomless pit for 1,000 years

But after these things he must be released for a little while.

The Saints reign with Christ for 1.000 years -- The Millennium

Revelation 20:4-6

Then I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded for their witness to Jesus and for the word of God, who had not worshiped the beast or his image, and had not received his mark on their foreheads or on their hands. This is the first resurrection. ⁶ Blessed and holy is he who has part in the first resurrection. Over such the second death has no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with Him a thousand years.

The last battle

The Apostle John, in the book of Revelation, wrote that Gog and Magog would occur after the 1,000 year reign of Christ.

In my research about the battle of Gog and Magog and the battle of Armageddon, I learned that some scholars think that Ezekiel is writing about the battle of Gog and Magog and John writes of the battle of Armageddon in Revelations. Many scholars, however, think that the battle of Gog and Magog and the battle of Armageddon are the same battle. In both events a great earthquake occurs that levels mountains. Since mountains can only be leveled once, it makes sense that both these terms refer to one battle. Below are the two accounts:

Ezekiel 38:18-20

¹⁸ "And it will come to pass at the same time, when Gog comes against the land of Israel," says the Lord God, "that My fury will show in My face. ¹⁹ For in My jealousy and in the fire of My wrath I have spoken: 'Surely in that day there shall be a great earthquake in the land of Israel, ²⁰ so that the fish of the sea, the birds of the

heavens, the beasts of the field, all creeping things that creep on the earth, and all men who are on the face of the earth shall shake at My presence. The mountains shall be thrown down, the steep places shall fall, and every wall shall fall to the ground.'

Ezekiel accounts are numerous:

Ezekiel 38: 1-6

38 Now the word of the LORD came to me, saying, ²"Son of man, set your face against Gog, of the land of Magog, the prince of Rosh, Meshech, and Tubal, and prophesy against him, ³and say, 'Thus says the Lord GOD: "Behold, I *am* against you, O Gog, the prince of Rosh, Meshech, and Tubal. ⁴I will turn you around, put hooks into your jaws, and lead you out, with all your army, horses, and horsemen, all splendidly clothed, a great company *with* bucklers and shields, all of them handling swords. ⁵Persia, Ethiopia, and Libya are with them, all of them *with* shield and helmet; ⁶Gomer and all its troops; the house of Togarmah *from* the far north and all its troops—many people *are* with you.

Ezekiel 39:1-10

39 "And you, son of man, prophesy against Gog, and say, 'Thus says the Lord GOD: "Behold, I *am* against you, O Gog, the prince of Rosh, Meshech, and Tubal; ²and I will turn you around and lead you on, bringing you up from the far north, and bring you against the mountains of Israel. ³Then I will knock the bow out of your left hand, and cause the arrows to fall out of your right hand. ⁴You shall fall upon the mountains of Israel, you and all your troops and the peoples who *are* with you; I will give you to birds of prey of every sort and *to* the beasts of the field to be devoured. ⁵You shall fall on the open field; for I have spoken," says the Lord GOD. ⁶"And I will send fire on Magog and on those who live in security in the coastlands. Then they shall know that I *am* the LORD. ⁷So I will make My holy name known in the midst of My people Israel, and I will not *let them* profane My holy name anymore. Then the nations shall know that I *am* the LORD, the Holy One in Israel. ⁸Surely it is coming, and it shall be done," says the Lord GOD. "This *is* the day of which I have spoken.

⁹"Then those who dwell in the cities of Israel will go out and set on fire and burn the weapons, both the shields and bucklers, the bows and arrows, the javelins and spears; and they will make fires with them for seven years. ¹⁰They will not take wood from the field nor cut down *any* from the forests, because they will make fires with the weapons; and they will plunder those who plundered them, and pillage those who pillaged them," says the Lord GOD.

Below is the only time the word "Armageddon" is found in the Bible.

Revelation 16:16

¹⁶ And they gathered them together to the place called in Hebrew, Armageddon.

Revelation 16:19-20

¹⁹ Now the great city was divided into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell. And great Babylon was remembered before God, to give her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of His wrath. ²⁰ Then every island fled away, and the mountains were not found.

These two were cast alive into the lake of fire burning with brimstone.

Revelation 20:11-13

¹¹ Then I saw a great white throne and Him who sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away. And there was found no place for them. ¹² And I saw the dead, small and great, standing before God, and books were opened. And another book was opened, which is the Book of Life. And the dead were judged according to their works, by the things which were written in the books. ¹³ The sea gave up the dead who were in it, and Death and Hades delivered up the dead who were in them. And they were judged, each one according to his works.

Revelation 20:15

¹⁵ And anyone not found written in the Book of Life was cast into the lake of fire.

A new heaven and a new earth**Isaiah 65:17-25**

¹⁷ "For behold, I create new heavens and a new earth;
And the former shall not be remembered or [a]come to mind.
¹⁸ But be glad and rejoice forever in what I create;
For behold, I create Jerusalem as a rejoicing,
And her people a joy.
¹⁹ I will rejoice in Jerusalem,
And joy in My people;
The voice of weeping shall no longer be heard in her,
Nor the voice of crying.
²⁰ "No more shall an infant from there live but a few days,
Nor an old man who has not fulfilled his days;
For the child shall die one hundred years old,
But the sinner being one hundred years old shall be accursed.
²¹ They shall build houses and inhabit them;
They shall plant vineyards and eat their fruit.
²² They shall not build and another inhabit;
They shall not plant and another eat;
For as the days of a tree, so shall be the days of My people,
And My elect shall long enjoy the work of their hands.
²³ They shall not labor in vain,
Nor bring forth children for trouble;

For they shall be the descendants of the blessed of the Lord,
And their offspring with them.

²⁴ "It shall come to pass

That before they call, I will answer;

And while they are still speaking, I will hear.

²⁵ The wolf and the lamb shall feed together,

The lion shall eat straw like the ox,

And dust *shall be* the serpent's food.

They shall not hurt nor destroy in all My holy mountain,"

Says the LORD.

Revelation 21

21 Now I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away. Also there was no more sea. ² Then I, John, saw the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. ³ And I heard a loud voice from heaven saying, "Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and He will dwell with them, and they shall be His people. God Himself will be with them and be their God. ⁴ And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes; there shall be no more death, nor sorrow, nor crying. There shall be no more pain, for the former things have passed away."

⁵ Then He who sat on the throne said, "Behold, I make all things new." And He said to me, "Write, for these words are true and faithful."

⁶ And He said to me, "It is done! I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End. I will give of the fountain of the water of life freely to him who thirsts. ⁷ He who overcomes shall inherit all things, and I will be his God and he shall be My son. ⁸ But the cowardly, unbelieving, abominable, murderers, sexually immoral, sorcerers, idolaters, and all liars shall have their part in the lake which burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death."

⁹ Then one of the seven angels who had the seven bowls filled with the seven last plagues came to me and talked with me, saying, "Come, I will show you the bride, the Lamb's wife." ¹⁰ And he carried me away in the Spirit to a great and high mountain, and showed me the great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God, ¹¹ having the glory of God. Her light was like a most precious stone, like a jasper stone, clear as crystal. ¹² Also she had a great and high wall with twelve gates, and twelve angels at the gates, and names written on them, which are the names of the twelve tribes of the children of Israel: ¹³ three gates on the east, three gates on the north, three gates on the south, and three gates on the west.

¹⁴ Now the wall of the city had twelve foundations, and on them were the names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb. ¹⁵ And he who talked with me had a gold reed to measure the city, its gates, and its wall. ¹⁶ The city is laid out as a square; its length is as great as its breadth. And he measured the city with the reed: twelve thousand furlongs. Its length, breadth, and height are equal. ¹⁷ Then he measured its wall: one hundred and forty-four cubits, according to the measure of a man, that is, of

an angel. ¹⁸ The construction of its wall was of jasper; and the city was pure gold, like clear glass. ¹⁹ The foundations of the wall of the city were adorned with all kinds of precious stones: the first foundation was jasper, the second sapphire, the third chalcedony, the fourth emerald, ²⁰ the fifth sardonyx, the sixth sardius, the seventh chrysolite, the eighth beryl, the ninth topaz, the tenth chrysoprase, the eleventh jacinth, and the twelfth amethyst. ²¹ The twelve gates were twelve pearls: each individual gate was of one pearl. And the street of the city was pure gold, like transparent glass.

²² But I saw no temple in it, for the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are its temple. ²³ The city had no need of the sun or of the moon to shine in it, for the glory of God illuminated it. The Lamb is its light. ²⁴ And the nations of those who are saved shall walk in its light, and the kings of the earth bring their glory and honor into it. ²⁵ Its gates shall not be shut at all by day (there shall be no night there). ²⁶ And they shall bring the glory and the honor of the nations into it. ²⁷ But there shall by no means enter it anything that defiles, or causes an abomination or a lie, but only those who are written in the Lamb's Book of Life.

Revelation 22

22 And he showed me a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding from the throne of God and of the Lamb. ² In the middle of its street, and on either side of the river, was the tree of life, which bore twelve fruits, each tree yielding its fruit every month. The leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations. ³ And there shall be no more curse, but the throne of God and of the Lamb shall be in it, and His servants shall serve Him. ⁴ They shall see His face, and His name shall be on their foreheads. ⁵ There shall be no night there: They need no lamp nor light of the sun, for the Lord God gives them light. And they shall reign forever and ever.

⁶ Then he said to me, "These words are faithful and true." And the Lord God of the holy prophets sent His angel to show His servants the things which must shortly take place.

⁷ "Behold, I am coming quickly! Blessed *is* he who keeps the words of the prophecy of this book."

⁸ Now I, John, saw and heard these things. And when I heard and saw, I fell down to worship before the feet of the angel who showed me these things.

⁹ Then he said to me, "See that you do not do that. For I am your fellow servant, and of your brethren the prophets, and of those who keep the words of this book.

Worship God." ¹⁰ And he said to me, "Do not seal the words of the prophecy of this book, for the time is at hand. ¹¹ He who is unjust, let him be unjust still; he who is filthy, let him be filthy still; he who is righteous, let him be righteous still; he who is holy, let him be holy still."

¹² "And behold, I am coming quickly, and My reward is with Me, to give to every one according to his work. ¹³ I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End, the First and the Last."

¹⁴ Blessed are those who do His commandments, that they may have the right to the tree of life, and may enter through the gates into the city. ¹⁵ But outside are dogs and

sorcerers and sexually immoral and murderers and idolaters, and whoever loves and practices a lie.

¹⁶ "I, Jesus, have sent My angel to testify to you these things in the churches. I am the Root and the Offspring of David, the Bright and Morning Star."

¹⁷ And the Spirit and the bride say, "Come!" And let him who hears say, "Come!" And let him who thirsts come. Whoever desires, let him take the water of life freely.

¹⁸ For I testify to everyone who hears the words of the prophecy of this book: If anyone adds to these things, God will add to him the plagues that are written in this book; ¹⁹ and if anyone takes away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part from the Book of Life, from the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book.

²⁰ He who testifies to these things says, "Surely I am coming quickly."
Amen. Even so, come, Lord Jesus!
